- 1. Applicants may apply who have met the requirements for graduation in the current school year from a high school in Woodford County.
- 2. The scholarship award will be in the amount of \$1000 and will be paid to the student's institution of higher learning. Scholarships will depend upon ASAP funds being made available through the Office of Drug Control Policy.
- 3. All applicants will complete the application form and provide a high school transcript (or equivalent). The application form can be obtained from the website, from a guidance counselor, or from a Family Resource Center coordinator.
- 4. All applicants will submit an essay.
- 5. All applicants will provide one letter of recommendation from a non-relative adult who can verify the skills and activities set forth in the application. Examples include an adult mentor, teacher, coach, community leader, pastor, or employer / supervisor.
- 6. The two "Leadership" scholarships will be based on a combination of factors including but not limited to: academic achievement, potential for success in higher education, community activities, and the essay.
- 7. In all matters, the Scholarship Committee shall have final discretion in the interpretation of guidelines and in the awarding of scholarships.
