Freeman Bailey, Chair – Members welcomed, and introductions of members made.

Guest Presentations

Frontier Nursing – Angela Bailey

Overview of history and current programming was provided. Frontier Nursing hopes to partner with the community to address needs and services; they have previously partnered during pandemic to assist with vaccination clinic and look forward to additional partnerships.

Crossroads Counseling/Bluewaters Assessment and Testing Services – David Waters

Overview of agency and development of additional testing services shared. Services include outpatient substance abuse services to include MAT, generalized therapy, drug testing services and targeted case management services. Services are Medicaid billable.

Budget

Nancy Blackford, Coordinator – budgets were reviewed and individuals in receipt of grant monies were encouraged to access/spend. General ASAP funds needs spent by 5-30-22 and Harm Reduction funds needs spent by 3-30-22. This is 30 days in advance of the grant closing and allows for payments to be processed. When money is spent send progress report to include amount utilized and number of persons assisted as a result.

Mini Grant applications for next year are open 12-1-21 through 12-30-21. Applications can be located on ASAP website.

Announcements- “Around the Table”

Lisa Johnson – M&M has spent a portion of their allotted mini-grant. Partnered with WCHD to provide education and prevention related to vaping and smoking. Also, able to provide personal hygiene kits.

Julie Snawder, Vice Chair – ASAP has discussed the formation of sub-committees and there is difficulty launching these. The goal was 3 but the interest has been limited. Nancy will continue her subcommittee in relation to detox services and the goal is to have others join Larry Blackford in the Community Education subcommittee. Jill Hargis and Jasmine Hazelwood have agreed to partner on that committee, but more are needed as attempts are made for this committee to encompass you. Lisa Johnson identified as potential contributor and Elley Sapp and Delores Roberts were invited.

Judge James Kay – Opiate Task Force lead by Larry Blackford will launch Woodford Aware in 2022 with goals to increase awareness on the propensity of addiction to opiates in a very short window of time, educate on alternative treatments aside from opiates being the first option and to focus on a goal of reducing the number of opiates being prescribed in the community. Ideally board members will be inclined to make face to face with area providers to share this knowledge and request fewer prescriptions in community.
